

# Summer ORISE Fellowship Opportunity at the CDC

## Program Description

A fellowship opportunity is available to support the Division of Health and Nutrition Examination Surveys, National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS), Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), in Hyattsville, Maryland.

The student will collaborate with a multi-disciplinary team of researchers on questions related to food and nutrient intake. The student will learn how to analyze National Health and Nutrition Examination Surveys (NHANES) data and contribute to a peer-reviewed publication. Ongoing projects in the branch include examination of added sugars, sugar sweetened beverages, urinary iodine, and breastfeeding indicators.

\* Length of appointment: 3 months \*

This program, administered by ORAU through its contract with the U.S. Department of Energy to manage the Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education, was established through an interagency agreement between DOE and CDC. The initial appointment is for 3 months, but may be renewed upon recommendation of CDC contingent on the availability of funds. The participant will receive a monthly stipend commensurate with educational level and experience. Proof of health insurance is required for participation in this program. The appointment is full-time at CDC in the Hyattsville, Maryland area. Participants do not become employees of CDC, DOE or the program administrator, and there are no employment-related benefits.

## Qualifications

- Knowledge of SAS, Stata or R is desired
- Coursework in Nutrition is desired
- Master's level student (or higher) in nutrition, public health or a related field
