INROADS has partnered with the U.S. Department of Interior's Bureau of Land Management (BLM) to offer challenging Internship opportunities for students from historically under-represented and under-served populations. BLM programs involve wildlife habitats, mineral deposits, energy, conservation, time, recreation, paleontology, historical land use and more. The BLM employs geoscientists in geology, physical science, civil engineering, mining, petroleum, hydrology and land conservation, as well as accounting, marketing, human resources, web technology, security and general office administration.

INTERNSHIPS run from June 5 - Aug 18, 2017, and include a bi-weekly stipend, housing stipend and round-trip travel.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- At least 17 years of age
- A U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- A current student or recent graduate (within two years of internship end date)
- A valid driver's license and a clean driving record for certain positions (documentation to be provided upon request)
- Ability to undergo a federal criminal history check
- Effective oral and written communication skills
